The scope of the project is to **promote sustainable furniture production as part of greening the processes and activities of SMEs** in the circular economy through strengthening the inter-linkage between the VET sector and business sector.

SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES

- Build the capacity of 18 VET Trainers to incorporate furniture labor market needs to their training provision;
- Enhance the green up-skilling or reskilling of 60 VET Learners through the improved capacity of VET Institutions to provide courses and learning resources that correspond to sustainable furniture production requirements
- Create support mechanisms that facilitate the collaboration between VET providers, VET learners and furniture business sector

THE MAIN RESULTS OF THE PROJECT

- **ONE RESEARCH REPORT**
At least 25 furniture companies will be identified to develop strong links with VET Providers to facilitate the exploitation and sustainability of results, and develop a network that facilitates the sharing of knowledge, experience, and expertise.
- **ONE ROADMAP**
VET access to 'skills for the green transition' for the preparation of strategic development plans with the workforce of furniture companies.
- **ONE TRAINING FORMAT**
Practical training modules to familiarize VET Providers with sustainable furniture production and coaching methods, didactical resources and tools for green up-skilling in the VET field.



- **STAKEHOLDER ENGAGEMENT**
At least 25 furniture companies will be identified to develop strong links with VET Providers to facilitate the exploitation and sustainability of results, and develop a network that facilitates the sharing of knowledge, experience, and expertise.
- **LOCAL ACTIVITIES**
60 VET Learners (furniture employees) prepared through green up-skilling or reskilling to obtain and keep jobs and progress in their professional development within the circular economy.
- **MULTIPLIER EVENTS**
At least 6 dissemination events with stakeholders from the public and private sector to initiate strategy alignment and better regulation through stakeholder engagement, counselling and matching services, new agenda setting etc.
- **ONE TRAINING COURSE**
18 VET Providers (trainers and teachers) prepared in up-skill or reskill interventions for the circular transition of the labour market in the furniture industry.
- **E-LEARNING PLATFORM**
Digital training through personal strategic planning, self-learning opportunity, self-assessment and recognition from the furniture SMEs in line with their demand and goals for the CBM adaption.
